Visitor restrictions continue to apply to residential aged care facilities in Victoria

The Premier of Victoria Daniel Andrews has today announced a further seven day extension to the current restrictions. As a result, the State Government directives for aged care facilities will remain in place until 11.59pm on Tuesday, 27 July 2021.

Unfortunately, that means visitors are still not permitted to enter residential aged care, with the exception of allowable exemptions in relation to compassionate, end-of-life or assistance visits.


We know this is extremely disappointing news for residents, their families and friends.
