## Restricted entry and precautionary measures in place at all residential aged care facilities in Tasmania

Due to the escalating COVID-19 situation in Victoria and New South Wales, together with this week's case in Launceston of an interstate traveller testing positive for COVID-19 while in hotel quarantine, the Director of Public Health in Tasmania has introduced a range of precautionary measures.

From midnight Thursday, 5 August, additional requirements will apply until further notice to all staff and visitors attending residential aged care facilities.

## These include:

- Mandatory wearing of face masks by staff and visitors
- A limit of two visitors per day per resident

Additionally, Victoria was reclassified as a high-risk area, adding to the existing list of New South Wales, some areas of Queensland and premises in Western Australia.

Anyone in Tasmania who has been in a high risk area or attended any of the high risk premises in the last 14 days is not permitted to enter a residential aged care facility.

The list of high risk areas and premises is updated several times each day at www.coronavirus.tas.gov.au/travelalert.

All staff, visitors, volunteers and contractors will continue to be screened on entry and required to complete a declaration form as well as sign in via the Check-in Tas app. If you do not meet the entry criteria (for example, you are unwell or have been exposed to COVID-19 or spent time in a high-risk area or premises in the last 14 days) you will not be permitted to enter and asked to immediately leave.

Please be assured that all COVID-Safe protocols are in place across Uniting AgeWell residences in Tasmania and we will continue to closely monitor the health and wellbeing of all residents in our care; their safety is paramount.

We will keep you informed regarding any further changes or restrictions to visiting guidelines and urge you to remain vigilant.
